Greg Boyle, S.J., is a NYTimes best-selling author of <u>Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion</u> and founder of *Home-boy Industries*, the largest gang-intervention, rehabilitation, and re-entry program in the world. He's a creative storyteller and advocate for restorative justice, right relationship and forgiveness.

Fr. Greg's story about the time he and three of his former gang members, a.k.a., "homies", were invited by Laura Bush to attend a national conference supporting youth. Fr. Greg gave a keynote address, and all three had dinner at the White House.

The following is is really a Christmas story: On the flight home, Gabriel, one of the three, tattooed from head to toe, engaged a flight attendant in conversation. His story of redemption and his appreciation of *Homeboys Industries* that gave him a second chance caused the flight attendant to burst into tears. As the homie spoke, the flight attendant caught a *true glimpse* of Gabriel and *saw him* as a person. She looked past the "packaging" of this young man and recognized him *in the shape of God's heart*.

Sometimes people cry when they see that.

Suddenly, *KIN*ship ~ for two souls feeling their worth...a flight attendant and a gang member...at 34,000 feet...exactly what God had in mind. - Tattoos on the Heart, Boyle.

Being Catholic 101: Christmas Traditions

St. Francis of Assisi started the tradition of the Nativity Creche in 1223 in a cave in Greccio, Italy, where he visited to celebrate Christmas Mass. St. Francis planned to celebrate Midnight Mass in the chapel of the Franciscan hermitage. He realized it wouldn't accommodate all the people.

So, he set the altar up in a nearby cave where he created the Nativity scene that would leave an everlasting impact on those who attended.

He prepared a manger, placed a statue of Christ in it, and brought an ox and donkey Into the cave. The scenery symbolized the poverty and humility of Christ's birth. Frustrated by the greed and materialism that consumed Italy at that time, St. Francis wanted to do something that would lead the people back to Christ.

A large group of people gathered to hear St. Francis preach that night. His words were so passionate that the people decided to change their ways. Some even believed the Christ statue came alive in the cradle.

Now the live nativity scene is recreated throughout the world. Many artworks have been inspired by the Nativity scene, too. St. Francis Nativity scene teaches us about Christ's humanity and humility. Does this Nativity scene awaken in you a desire to recommit to Christ?



Christmas celebrates the birth of Jesus.in the town of Behlehem, a name that means, "House of Bread" over 2,000 years ago. Jesus, who is God, loved us so much, that he became human, just like us. He became human so he could teach us and show us how to be loving, compassionate, joyful, and

Jesus looked just like other babies who were born in his country of Israel. He would have had his mother's dark skin, hair, and eyes.

He would grow up in a loving family, with Mary, his mother and Joseph, his foster father. They would teach him how to pray, to be helpful and kind, and to learn the other things the children learned at that time.

Jesus, born into a poor family, would grow up to take care of the poor, the needy, and all the people who came to him for healing or forgiveness.

Spend time each day in prayer, thanking Jesus for the great gift of his birth, his love, and his life. Pray that you can be just like Jesus each day.
