Life is bipolar, a complex network of opposite relationships. You fluidly flow back and forth in your bipolar heart. Your bipolar heart is best described in the parable of the weeds' destructive, choking force and their opposite image, the wheat's life-giving, abundant harvest.

In today's gospel, Jesus tells three parables to illustrate humanity's bipolar heart. Jesus knew his audience. The Weeds and the Wheat, The Mustard Seed, and the Leaven/Yeast parables were heard by some folks who were part of the agrarian community.

The Divine Storyteller flawlessly drew spiritual images for the crowd so they could draw their own conclusions about the Kindom of God/the Reign of God.

The Weeds and the Wheat are a prime example of a spiritual bipolar heart. Your vices (weeds) are always present with your virtues (wheat). The Wisdom of The Divine Storyteller is evidenced in how accepting he accepts you, just as you are, even with your weedy, bipolar heart.

In accepting you as you are, Jesus expects you to extend this same grace to others, with all their vices and virtues. There is no allowance for sorting, dividing, or judging others into neat little piles of who's acceptable to you and who isn't, who's wrong and who's right, who's worthy or unworthy of your love and presence.

Even with all your weediness, faults, shortcomings, and failures, Christ's love for you is truly unconditional. You are not condemned for your weedy, bipolar heart. Instead, you are offered merciful forgiveness. In turn, Christ expects you to do the same for your Neighbors, and offer them the same compassion, mercy, and forgiveness so you grow together in God's Field.

Whenever Jesus encountered a sinner he offered them mercy, kindness, and compassion, not shunning judgment. It doesn't take much to realize your way of separating the weeds and the wheat is not Christ's Way. All will be done in Divine Time and not in your schedule.

Each of us and all of us together *are* The Weeds and the Wheat. Accept the Divine Wisdom of the Storyteller whose parable perfectly describes your imperfections and God's perfect love.

how merciful God is to you ~ and all of us!


Be grateful for God's mercy and all the chances God gives you


