


Please do your part: donate items, come to the Yard Sale and buy something!

For us, **Pentecost** is celebrated 50 days after Easter. This feast is Peter and the Apostles proclaimed Jesus Christ as the Savior of called the Birthday of the Church. For the firt time, on this day, the world ~ and our Faith Community is born!!
