





November 30, 2025 ~ 1st Sunday of Advent

- ☛ We do not know the hour when we will be called to give an accounting of our Stewardship. During Advent how will you be more awake to ways you can share your faith?

December 7, 2025 ~ 2nd Sunday of Advent

- ☛ We must be good stewards of God's gifts to us, receiving them gratefully and cultivating them with care lest we be the ones about whom John the Baptist speaks today: "Every tree that does not bear good fruit will be cut down and thrown into the fire"

December 14, 2025 ~ 3rd Sunday of Advent

- ☛ Each of us has his or her role to play in the coming of the Kingdom of God, then called John the Baptist to be the herald of the Messiah, preparing the way of the Lord. How is God calling me to be a herald for Christ?

December 21, 2025 ~ 4th Sunday of Advent

- ☛ When he discovered that Mary was with child, Joseph resolved to end their engagement with as little disgrace as possible. Being obedient to the voice of God, he changed those plans and became instead the protector of the child Jesus and his mother Mary. God grant that I may be as open to the leading of the Holy Spirit. How is God calling you to a new obedience?

December 28, 2025 ~ Feast of the Holy Family

- ☛ Joseph's obedience to God was not a one-time thing. His attention to the angel's warning kept Jesus from being murdered by Herod and led to the fulfillment of the prophecy that the Messiah would be a Nazorean. Fidelity to God's will assures the best use of my talents, too!
